

**EASTBOURNE WALKING WEEKEND**  
**25<sup>TH</sup> & 26<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2010**

Here is the itinerary for the above walking weekend being organised by Kerry O'Grady and Mark Jones. Mark knows the area very well and has kindly offered to lead the walks on both days. For both walks try and car share as much as possible to save car parking charges and do our bit for the environment too.

**Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> Seven Sisters**

We meet at Birling Gap car park (costs £2.50/day although free if you're a NT member and display your card, remember to bring loose change) BN20 0AB, grid ref; TV553960 at 10.15am. There is a National Trust tearoom here and also toilets, this is a 15 minute drive from Eastbourne.

This circular walk is just over 12 miles, starting over the Seven Sisters hills with lovely sea views, then onto Litlington, then some more hills to Jevington. More hills and back to Birling Gap - basically this is a pretty hilly but rewarding walk which took Mark and I just over 5 hours to complete at a good pace with a very quick refreshment stop. There are other stops on the way for toilets and possibly a very quick stop at a tearoom or pub for a drink and use of toilets, **but please bring a packed lunch and water.**

**Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> Alfriston**

On Sunday we meet again at Birling Gap car park at 10am, where we will drive on to Alfriston car park (£4/day please bring some loose change). The drive is on country lanes, only 15 minutes again, but not necessarily well marked, so following our convoy is best unless you know the area well).

The walk from Alfriston is 8 miles and again quite hilly. It will take us to the Long Man of Wilmington, over some hills via Jevington and back to Alfriston. There is one toilet stop on this walk. Again, **please bring a packed lunch and water.**
